

ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DISMISS

Before this Court is Defendants' Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Viable Medical Affidavit.

MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Richey L. Andrew, ("Plaintiff") is an inmate incarcerated in the Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) and is currently housed at Northern Nevada Correctional Center (NNCC) in Carson City, Nevada. Plaintiff filed his state tort law medical malpractice Complaint on March 9, 2016.

II. COURT'S ANALYSIS

In an action for medical malpractice in the district court, NRS 41A.071 unambiguously requires that:

"the district court shall dismiss the action, without prejudice, if the action is filed without an affidavit, supporting the allegations contained in the action, submitted by a medical expert who practices or has practiced in an area that is substantially similar to the type of practice engaged in at the time of the alleged malpractice."

NRS 41A.071 (emphasis added).

1 “[T]he NRS 41A.071 affidavit requirement is a preliminary procedural rule subject to the
2 notice-pleading standard, and thus, it must be ‘liberally construed . . . in a manner that is
3 consistent with [the Supreme Court’s] NRCP 12 jurisprudence.” *Zohar v. Zbiegien*, 130 Nev.
4 ___, ___, 334 P.3d 402, 406 (2014).

5 “The plain language of NRS 41A.071 makes no mention of professional negligence.
6 NRS 41A.071 refers expressly to ‘medical malpractice,’ which in turn is defined as pertaining
7 to physicians,¹ hospitals,² and hospital employees.” *Egan v. Chambers*, 129 Nev. ___, ___,
8 299 P.3d 364 (2013) (quoting NRS 41A.009).

9 “A medical malpractice complaint filed without a supporting medical expert affidavit is
10 void *ab initio*, meaning it is of no force and effect. Because a complaint that does not comply
11 with NRS 41A.071 is void *ab initio*, it does not legally exist . . . ” *Wheble v. Eight Judicial Dist.*
12 *Court*, 128 Nev. ___, ___, 272 P.3d 134, 137 (2012) (citing *Washoe Medical Center v. Dist.*
13 *Court*, 122 Nev. 1298, 1304, 148 P.3d 790, 794 (2006) (footnote omitted)). In other words,
14 the presence of a proper affidavit confers jurisdiction on the Court to hear a medical
15 malpractice case. See *Szydel v. Markman*, 121 Nev. 453, 461, 117 P.3d 200, 205 (2005)
16 (Hardesty, J., *dissenting*). Thus, this Court lacks jurisdiction to hear Plaintiffs case and must
17 dismiss it.

18 **III. ORDER**

19 The COURT FINDS that Plaintiff intended to file an action for medical malpractice, and
20 knew about the requirements of NRS 41A.071, as evidenced by his attached, self-attested
21 “Affidavit” wherein he explains why he did not include the required affidavit.

22 The COURT FINDS that Plaintiff failed to adhere to the plain language of NRS
23 41A.071, by filing an action for medical malpractice in the district court without an affidavit
24 from a medical expert supporting the allegations contained in the action.




