

ORDER DIRECTING ANSWER

This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges two subpoenas duces tecum served on petitioner by respondent State Bar of Nevada, the objection to which was denied by the Chair of respondent Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board. Having reviewed the petition, it appears that an answer may assist this court in resolving this matter. Therefore, respondent State Bar shall have 30 days from the date of this order within which to file and serve an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the request writ. NRAP 21(b)(1).
