
*ORDER GRANTING MOTION*

This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenging two subpoenas duces tecum served on petitioner by respondent State Bar of Nevada. Petitioner has filed an untimely (30 days) motion for an extension of time to file a reply to respondent's answer to the petition and submitted a copy of the proposed reply. In support of the motion, counsel for petitioner states he was not certain whether he could file a reply or had to wait for a directive from this court. Our September 16, 2016, order directed petitioner to file any reply to the answer within 15 days from service of respondent's answer. Thus, it appears counsel failed to properly review this court's order. The State Bar of Nevada has filed a response to the motion, noting that the underlying disciplinary matter is scheduled for January 12 and 13, 2017, but does not specifically oppose the extension request. Counsel for petitioner is admonished for failing to timely file the extension motion. Nevertheless,
