**NEVADA LABOR COMMISSIONER'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWERING BRIEF AND APPENDIX**

Respondent Nevada Labor Commissioner, by and through its counsel, the Office of the Attorney General., hereby moves this Court for an order extending the time in which to submit Respondent's Answering Brief and Appendix by fourteen (14) days. This Motion is made and based upon Rule 26(b) of the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure, the following memorandum of points and authorities and exhibits thereto, the pleadings and papers on file herein, and any oral argument the Court may allow.

I. RELIEF SOUGHT

Respondent Nevada Labor Commissioner hereby seeks an Order extending the time in which to submit its Answering Brief and Appendix by fourteen (14) days from January 16, 2018, up to and including January 30, 2018.

II. DISCUSSION

This appeal arises from an underlying case, in the District Court of Clark County, in the matter Bombardier Transportation (Holdings) Inc. v. Nevada Labor Commissioner; The International Union of Elevator Constructors; and Clark County, in the Supreme Court of the State of Nevada, Case No. 71101.

The undersigned elderly father-in-law was hospitalized in Henderson, Nevada on November 30, 2017. His condition deteriorated during the month of December and he passed away on January 5, 2018. This placed a significant strain on the time upon which the undersigned could work on this and other matters. The hospitalization was the primary reason for the request for a two week extension obtained by telephone on December 29, 2017. The undersigned has not quite finished the briefing, so is requesting two additional weeks to complete and file the briefing.

III. CONCLUSION

Respondent Nevada Labor Commissioner therefore requests a fourteen (14) day extension of time in which to file its Respondent's Answering Brief and

Appendix. There has been no objection from counsel for the other parties. The request is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay.
