

- DEFT'S PRO SE MOTION TO DISMISS COUNSEL & APPOINTMENT OF ALTERNATIVE COUNSEL...SENTENCING

Ms. Rochelle Nguyen also appearing on behalf of Defendant in Case No. C306032-2. Court indicated Defendant filed a motion for appointment of alternate counsel. The motion appeared to be racially motivated requesting that he be appointed an African American attorney, and the motions were denied; however Ms. Nguyen indicated that Defendant intended to withdraw his letters and Motion, as was confirmed by Defendant. Therefore, COURT ORDERED Defendant's Pro Se Motion to Dismiss Counsel and Appointment of Alternative Counsel WITHDRAWN.

DEFT. 




