


ORDER DIRECTING ANSWER AND GRANTING MOTION FOR STAY


This original petition for a writ of prohibition or mandamus challenges a district court oral order granting a motion to compel production of certain documents. Petitioner has also moved for a stay of the district court's order pending resolution of this petition. Having considered the petition, it appears that an answer to the petition will assist this court in resolving this matter. Therefore, real parties in interest, on behalf of respondents, shall have 30 days from the date of this order within which to file an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. Petitioner shall have 15 days from service of the answer to file and serve any reply. In light of the foregoing, we

grant the motion to stay. The district court's oral order granting the motion to compel, issued on September 8, 2016, shall be stayed until further order of the court.

It is so ORDERED.
