During oral argument of plaintiff Cotter's writ petition yesterday, the Court inquired about the absence in the record of a written order from the district court confirming the granting of defendants' motion to compel on September 8, 2016 that became the subject of the writ that was argued yesterday, January 3, 2018. Upon review of the subject with defendant's counsel and today with the district court, we learned that a written order had been submitted to the district court by the defendants on September 16, 2016 but was not signed by the district court because on September 15 this Court entered a stay of the "district court's oral order granting motion to compel . . . until further order from this court."

Procedural Order 16-28722. Please see the district court's minutes for today, January 04, 2018, which confirms this fact and directs defendants' local counsel, H. Stan Johnson, "to resubmit the order." The minutes are marked as plaintiff's Appendix page next in order, 721. Plaintiff will again supplement the record with the written order as soon as it has been signed by the district court.

Under these circumstances, plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court not decline to entertain this writ petition because the district

court failed to sign the written order submitted to her on September 16, 2016.
