Dear Justices:

Nevada is fortunate to have many qualified attorneys who are willing to serve on the Board of Governors. The rules related to the lifetime limits ought to be re-examined. Due to the length of time that many of us will practice law and the longevity that many of us enjoy as a result of both medical advances and the knowledge gained from healthy living, the lifetime limits should be revisited. Although I support ADKT 519, I think that in addition to the additional years of service that ADKT 519 affords a governor, there ought to also be an ability to return to the Board of Governors after a cooling off period of 5-10 years. At that point the attorneys in the District may decide if that person should continue service.

I am happy to respond to any inquiries of other commentators or the Court. Thank you for your consideration.

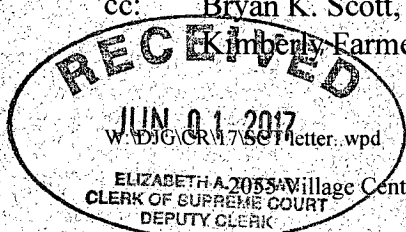
