MOTION FOR AN ORDER ALLOWING APPELLANTS ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE REPLY BRIEF

Appellants, Jacqueline M. Montoya and Kathryn A. Bouvier ("Appellants"), hereby move this Honorable Court for an order continuing the filing deadline for their reply brief from October 3, 2017 to October 24, 2017. This motion is supported by the memorandum of points and authorities found herein below.

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MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. Background

- 1. Respondent filed her Answering Brief on August 4, 2017.
- 2. On August 15, 2017, Marquis Aurbach Coffing ("MAC") filed its Motion for Leave to File an Amicus Brief (the "Amicus Motion"), which attached its proposed Amicus Curiae Brief in Support of Respondent's Answering Brief (the "Amicus Brief").
- 3. On August 28, 2017, the Appellants filed a stipulation by and between the Appellants and Respondence under which the deadline for the Appellants to file their reply brief was extended from September 5, to September 19th. The Court approved the parties' stipulation the same day it was filed.
- 4. On August 29, 2017, the Court granted MAC's Amicus Motion and ordered the Amicus Brief to be filed by the Clerk of the Court.
- 5. On September 5, 2017, Appellants filed their Motion for an Order Allowing Appellants to Respond to Marquis Aurbach Coffing's Amicus Curiae Brief in Support of Respondent's Answering Brief (the "Motion for Response").
- 6. On September 11, 2017, the Court issued an order granting the Motion for Response which instructed the Appellants to respond to the Amicus Brief as part of their reply brief. This order also extended the Appellants' deadline to file the reply brief from September 19th to October 3rd.

7. On October 1, 2017, Joseph J. Powell, lead counsel for the Appellants, sustained a gunshot wound¹ at the country musical festival where an armed gunman attacked hundreds of concert goers.

II. Argument

NRAP 26(b)(1)(A) allows this Court to "extend the time prescribed by these Rules or by its orders to perform any act" when "good cause" is shown. Although the Appellants have made significant progress in drafting their reply brief, it cannot be finalized without the input of lead counsel, Joseph Powell. It is anticipated that Mr. Powell will be unable to participate in finalizing the reply brief for at least two weeks due to his injuries. Accordingly, Appellants believe that good cause exists to extend the deadline for the reply brief from October 3rd to October 24th.

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¹ Although Mr. Powell was shot, he is expected to make a full recovery.

III. Conclusion

For the aforementioned reasons, the Appellants ask that this Honorable Court issue an order extending the deadline for the Appellants to file their reply brief to October 24, 2017.
