

ORDER GRANTING STAY

This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus challenging a district court order that denied the State's motion to admit certain evidence at trial. The State has filed a motion to stay the proceedings below pending this court's resolution of the writ petition. The motion is unopposed. Having reviewed the documents on file herein, we conclude that a stay is warranted pending our further consideration of the writ petition, and we therefore grant the motion. NRAP 8(c); *State v. Robles-Nieves*, 129 Nev. 537, 306 P.3d 399 (2013). The proceedings against Jeffrey Lynn Baker in District Court Case No. C-14-303315-1 are stayed pending further order of this court.
