NRS 34.724(1).
- 2. Here, the claim that Petitioner put forward in the instant Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) is not cognizable.
- 3. Indeed, the instant Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) does not perceptibly challenge Petitioner's sentence or claim that the time Petitioner has served pursuant to the judgment of conviction has been improperly computed.
- 4. Accordingly, as Petitioner has not put forward a claim in accordance with NRS 34.724, the instant Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) lacks merit.
