ORDER DENYING MOTION

Respondent has filed a motion for a second extension of time (30 days) to file the fast track response. Respondent's motion is nearly identical to the previous motion and counsel offers the exact same reasons proffered in support of the previous motion (lengthy appendix; numerous complex sub-issues). Respondent has failed to demonstrate extreme need or merit warranting a second 30-day extension of time to file the fast track response. See NRAP 3C(i)(2)(B). Accordingly, the motion is denied. Respondent shall have until August 11, 2017, to file and serve the fast track response. We caution respondent's counsel that failure to comply may result in the imposition of sanctions. See NRAP 3C(n); NRAP 31(d).
