

ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY STAY IN PART

Petitioner has filed a motion for a stay of the district court proceedings pending resolution of the petition for a writ of mandamus.¹ Having considered the motion, we grant it in part. See NRAP 8(c); Mikohn Gaming Corp. v. McCrea, 120 Nev. 248, 251, 89 P.3d 36, 38 (2004). The portion of the district court's October 17, 2016, order awarding attorney fees in the amount of \$19,846.00 for work performed by the law firm of Lewis Brisbois is temporarily stayed pending receipt and consideration of

any opposition to the motion. The motion is denied in all other respects. Real parties in interest shall have 11 days from the date of this order to file any opposition to the motion for stay. Petitioner shall have 7 days from the date of service of the opposition to file any reply.

It appears from the record that the district court may enter an order ruling on a pending motion to dismiss petitioner's complaint on February 17, 2017. Such an order may moot or otherwise affect the pending writ petition. Accordingly, petitioner shall have 5 days from the date of this order to provide this court with a copy of the district court's order regarding the pending motion to dismiss or otherwise inform this court, in writing, of the status of the district court proceedings.

It is so ORDERED.
