**STIPULATION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE
RESPONDENT STATE OF NEVADA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION'S ANSWERING BRIEF**

Pursuant to NRAP 31(b)(2), the parties hereby stipulate and agree to allow Respondent State of Nevada, Department of Transportation (NDOT) up to and including August 14, 2017, to file its answering brief.
