Becker V (the "Becker Respondents") for breach of contract, breach of the implied covenant of good faith and fair dealing, conversion/constructive trust/embezzlement, declaratory relief, battery, injunctive relief, and breach of fiduciary duty.

On June 14, 2016, the Appellants and Becker Respondents entered into settlement of the claims in the case. However, on August 25, 2016, former legal counsel for Appellants, Respondent Christopher D. Sullivan, Esq. ("Sullivan"), filed a Notice of Attorneys' Lien, claiming unpaid attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$362,880.00 (the "Attorneys' Lien").

On September 13, 2016, the Appellants filed a Motion for Adjudication of Attorneys' Lien. On October 25, 2016, the Court entered an Order in which the Court adjudicated the Attorneys' Lien, awarding to Sullivan the sum of \$305,370.00 in relation to his Attorneys' Lien (the "Fee Order"). The Fee Order addresses multiple issues. However, Appellant is only appealing that portion of the Fee Order which relates to the amount of the Attorney's Lien.

At the Court's direction, Mr. Sullivan explained the fire occurred on Saturday afternoon; parties had been in settlement negotiations all afternoon; it was a dumpster fire that shut down Beck's Group's operations; everyone is aware of it; Mr. Jimmerson was gone for a week and now Mr. Santoro is going on vacation. Mr. Sullivan stated he cannot facilitate everything by himself. Mr. Santoro noted he is new to this case and got involved a week or two ago; with regards to settlement negotiations, they have had extensive discussions, but he can represent that no agreement has been signed because the parties did not reach an agreement on all of the issues; the termination of the management agreement is separate and apart from the so-called global agreement; however, there is no binding agreement; he opposes advancing the motion date because they are new to this case and will need an opportunity to file opposition papers. Mr. Sullivan noted he was mistaken about Mr. Santoro's travels; he had spoken to someone at the office and thought Mr. Santoro was leaving Thursday; he simply needs a method of facilitating those loans. Following further argument regarding the properties, Yardi software, and whether or not there is a settlement, COURT ORDERED, hearing on the motion for temporary restraining order on order shortening time and motion for preliminary injunction ADVANCED to Tuesday, April 5, 2016, at 8:30 AM. Further, Mr. Sullivan is REQUIRED to SUPPLEMENT by 2:00 PM tomorrow, March 30th, with the specific relief he is asking for, not just the status quo, because the Court is concerned that it cannot identify what the status quo is even from the briefing.

Mr. Jimmerson stated, on behalf of Mr. and Mrs. Becker, there is nothing explosive here. Mr. Santoro noted the preliminary issue of what relief Plaintiffs are seeking. Arguments by Mr. Sullivan, Mr. Jimmerson, and Mr. Santoro regarding background of the case and settlement negotiations. List of items in Exhibit I to Mr. Jimmerson's brief MARKED as Court's Exhibit 1; properties Plaintiffs believe are to be turned over to them MARKED as Court's Exhibit 2. RECESS.

Proceedings resumed. Further arguments by counsel. Mr. Jimmerson's 2-page letter plus 8-page enclosure MARKED collectively as Court's Exhibit 3.

COURT ORDERED, as it appears there are issues related to whether parties actually accepted and partially performed the settlement agreement, an evidentiary hearing needs to be SET. Pending that hearing, the Court enters an INTERIM ORDER, which is not an injunctive relief order, to secure certain assets remaining in the form they are in until a hearing is held on whether there was a settlement or not. The items on Court's Exhibit 1 have already been transferred to some of the Defendants, and the Plaintiffs have no involvement in those. With respect to the remaining assets, the Court ORDERS NO FURTHER ENCUMBRANCES on those properties without an agreement between the parties. With respect to the bank accounts, those will be TRANSFERRED to Ernest Becker IV for him to have whatever he thinks is appropriate to manage those properties. All electronically stored information related to the transferred properties will be PROVIDED to Ernest Becker IV and/or his designee, so management of those properties can continue. Sallie Becker will be PROVIDED access to any of the accounting information, as she is a member of Becks Group; this does not require her to access the office space at times when no one else is there.

Court directed Defendants to identify on Court's Exhibit 1 what they do not have, and need. Mr. Ernest Becker V advised, as to the items with an "x", they do not have the accounting; hard copy files which would include loan documents, bank accounts, any leases with any of the vendors, and any utility company agreements; keys, as they cannot access the manager's offices and the storage units; access to Yardi, as they need to make sure vendors are paid. Mr. Ernest Becker V further advised, with regards to properties that do not have an "x", they have not received any development items, hard files, such as plans and permits; if he has missed anything, he would refer to one of the documents in their filings that contains everything.

Court NOTED, it does not have a list of properties that are not on Court's Exhibit 1. Court further CLARIFIED, to the extent there are properties commonly owned on Court's Exhibit 1, its order of no further encumbrances will APPLY to those properties as well.

Mr. Sullivan advised everything on Court's Exhibit 1 that has an "x" belongs to Mr. and Mrs. Becker, and everything else is owned by his clients. Court reiterated there will be no further encumbrances, as that protects Plaintiffs' interest; eventually, a determination will be made as to how not only the management but ownership of the properties is split up.
