*ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS*

Despite its untimeliness and cause appearing, appellant's motion for an extension of time to file the docketing statement is granted. NRAP 14(d). The clerk shall file the docketing statement received on January 23, 2017.

Appellant, who is proceeding *in forma pauperis*, has also filed a motion for this court to accept a late request for transcripts and a transcript request form pursuant to NRAP 9(b). Despite its untimeliness and cause appearing, the motion is granted. The clerk of this court shall file the transcript request form received on January 26, 2017. At this stage of the proceedings, we are unable to determine which transcripts, if any, are necessary for this court's review on appeal, see NRAP 9(b)(1)(C), and therefore, we decline to order the preparation of the requested transcripts at this time. However, as this appeal proceeds, we will consider the necessity of transcripts and may order their preparation at a later date.
