



1 **FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 On November 14, 2012, JASON JONES (hereinafter "Defendant") was charged by way
3 of Information with Murder with Use of a Deadly Weapon (Category A Felony – NRS
4 200.010, 200.030, 193.165). On January 22, 2013, Defendant's five-day jury trial
5 commenced. The jury's verdict finding Defendant guilty of Second Degree Murder with Use
6 of a Deadly weapon was filed in open court on January 29, 2013.

7 On April 4, 2013, Defendant was adjudged guilty and sentenced to the Nevada
8 Department of Corrections (NDC) as follows: Life with the possibility of parole after ten years
9 plus a consecutive term of 240 months maximum and 60 months minimum for Use of a Deadly
10 Weapon; with 287 days credit for time served. The Judgment of Conviction was filed on April
11 29, 2013.

12 On May 3, 2013, Defendant filed a Notice of Appeal. The Nevada Supreme Court
13 reversed and remanded on May 23, 2014, due to the Court's failure to give Defendant's
14 proposed jury instruction. Jones v. State, Order of Reversal and Remand, Docket No. 63136
15 (April 25, 2014).

16 On August 22, 2014, an Amended Information charging Defendant with Voluntary
17 Manslaughter with Use of a Deadly Weapon (Category B Felony – NRS 200.040, 200.050,
18 200.080, 193.165) was filed in open court, pursuant to negotiations. A Guilty Plea Agreement
19 ("GPA") was also filed on that same day. Within the GPA, parties stipulated to a sentence of
20 four to ten years in the NDC, plus a consecutive term of four to ten years in the NDC for the
21 deadly weapon enhancement. Guilty Plea Agreement, p. 1 (August 22, 2014).

22 On October 2, 2014, Defendant was adjudged guilty of Voluntary Manslaughter with
23 Use of a Deadly Weapon and sentenced to a minimum of 48 months in the NDC with a
24 maximum term of 120 months plus a consecutive term of a minimum of 48 months and a
25 maximum term of 120 months for the deadly weapon enhancement; and 834 days credit for
26 time served. The Judgment of Conviction was filed on October 3, 2014. Defendant did not
27 appeal his conviction.

1 On September 8, 2015, Defendant filed "Petitioner's Reply to Respondent's Opposition
2 to Motion to Modify and/or Correct Illegal Sentence/ NRS 34.724 et. seq."¹ On October 29,
3 2015, Defendant filed a Motion to Modify and/or Correct Illegal Sentence/NRS 34.724 et. seq.
4 The State filed its response on November 17, 2015. On November 19, 2015, Defendant's
5 motion was denied. The Order denying the motion was filed on December 18, 2015.

6 On October 26, 2015, Defendant filed the instant Petition for Habeas Corpus (Post-
7 Conviction). On November 12, 2015, Defendant filed a Supplemental Addendum to the Writ
8 filed on October 26, 2015. The State filed its Response on December 30, 2015.

9 **DEFENDANT'S PETITION IS TIME-BARRED PURSUANT TO NRS 34.726**

10 The Court finds Defendant's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus is time barred pursuant
11 to NRS 34.726(1):

12 Unless there is *good cause* shown for delay, a petition that
13 challenges the validity of a judgment or sentence must be filed
14 within 1 year of the entry of the judgment of conviction or, if an
15 appeal has been taken from the judgment, within 1 year after the
16 Supreme Court issues its remittitur. For the purposes of this
17 subsection, good cause for delay exists if the petitioner
demonstrates to the satisfaction of the court:

- 18 (a) That the delay is not the fault of the petitioner; and
19 (b) That dismissal of the petition as untimely will
20 unduly prejudice the petitioner.

21 The Supreme Court of Nevada has held that NRS 34.726 should be construed by its
22 plain meaning. Pellegrini v. State, 117 Nev. 860, 873-74, 34 P.3d 519, 528 (2001). The one-
23 year time bar set forth in NRS 34.726 begins to run from the date the Judgment of Conviction
24 is filed or a remittitur from a timely direct appeal is filed. Dickerson v. State, 114 Nev. 1084,
25 1087, 967 P.2d 1132, 1133-34 (1998).

26 The one-year time limit for preparing petitions for post-conviction relief under NRS
27 34.726 is strictly applied. In Gonzales v. State, 118 Nev. 590, 596, 53 P.3d 901, 904 (2002),
28 the Nevada Supreme Court rejected a habeas petition that was filed two days late despite
evidence presented by the defendant that he purchased postage through the prison and mailed
the notice within the one-year time limit. Gonzales reiterated the importance of filing the

¹ The Court notes this title is erroneous in that this was Petitioner's initial filing.

1 petition within the mandatory deadline, absent a showing of "good cause" for the delay in
2 filing. 118 Nev. at 590, 53 P.3d at 902.

3 The Court finds that the Judgment of Conviction was filed on October 3, 2014.
4 Defendant did not file a direct appeal. Therefore, the one-year time bar began to run from
5 October 3, 2014. See Dickerson, 114 Nev. at 1087, 967 P.2d at 1133-34. Defendant's petition
6 was filed on October 26, 2015, 24 days past the mandatory one year deadline. The Court finds
7 Defendant failed to establish good cause for this delay and therefore the Petition is denied as
8 procedurally barred.

9 **DEFENDANT IS NOT ENTITLED TO AN EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

10 A defendant is entitled to an evidentiary hearing if his petition is supported by specific
11 factual allegations, which, if true, would entitle him to relief unless the factual allegations are
12 repelled by the record. Marshall v. State, 110 Nev. 1328, 1331, 885 P.2d 603, 605 (1994).
13 "The judge or justice, upon review of the return, answer and all supporting documents which
14 are filed, shall determine whether an evidentiary hearing is required." NRS 34.770(1).
15 However, "[a] defendant seeking post-conviction relief is not entitled to an evidentiary hearing
16 on factual allegations belied or repelled by the record." Hargrove, 100 Nev. 498, 503, 686
17 P.2d 222, 225 (1984).

18 The Court finds Defendant's petition is procedurally barred and filed past the deadline.
19 Thus, Defendant's claims do not necessitate an evidentiary hearing. Therefore, Defendant's
20 request for an evidentiary hearing is denied.






