

1 and/or days wherein Feliciano loses the use of her motor controls and experiences
2 extreme weakness in her limbs.

3
4 Accordingly, she is then physically incapable of performing the physical
5 activity required to prepare the opening brief in the instant case.

6
7 Feliciano recently had further diagnostic testing, which resulted in an
8 additional diagnosis of a potentially fatal comorbid medical condition. This
9 comorbid diagnosis has resulted in Feliciano having to devote, unexpectedly,
10 significant time and attention to the coordination of follow-up medical visits,
11 further diagnostic testing, and making all provisions for her treatment protocol.
