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APPELLANT LIPSITZ'S SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE APPELLANT'S OPENING BRIEF

COMES NOW Appellant LIPSITZ, by and through AMY A FELICIANO, ESQ., and moves this Honorable Court to grant a short extension of time to file Appellant Lipsitz's Opening Brief by December 4, 2017.
