## **MEMORANDUM**

I, JONATHAN VANBOSKERCK, am a duly licensed attorney in the State of Nevada and am employed by the Clark County District Attorney's Office.

Respondent's Answering Brief is currently due on July 2, 2018. This is an appeal from a Judgment of Conviction. This Court may extend the time to file a Respondent's Answering Brief upon a clear showing of good cause. NRAP 31(b)(3). Further extensions may be granted upon a showing of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. <u>Id.</u>

The State herein makes its second request for an enlargement of time. The State requests twenty (20) days to include Monday, July 23, 2018, within which to file Respondent's Answering Brief.

Appellant filed his Opening Brief on April 2, 2018, after receiving six (6) extensions of time.
