



*ORDER STAYING ISSUANCE OF THE REMITTITUR*

Appellant's motion to stay issuance of the remittitur for 90 days pending the filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court is granted. See NRAP 41(b)(3). If such notice is not received by February 16, 2021, the clerk shall issue the remittitur.
