Dear Ms. Brown:

I have been informed that administrative Docket 522 is up for consideration by the Nevada Supreme Court. It represents a change in Nevada Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 35 regarding the mental or physical examinations of plaintiffs in injury cases. I am aware there are three versions of that docket number up for consideration. I strongly believe that the rule should be changed to allow audio recordings of independent medical examinations and that an observer be present. I believe this would protect the clients and patients and ensure that proper physical or mental examinations are performed. This measure is very similar to what the law has been in California for many years.
