STIPULATION TO EXTEND BRIEFING

(Third Request)

Pursuant to Rules 26(b)(2) and 31(b)(2) of the Nevada Rules of
Appellate Procedure (“NRAP”), Appellant Michelle Flores, by and through her

1 attorneys of record, the law firms of Ashcraft & Barr LLP and Iglody Law,
2 PLLC, and Respondent Las Vegas-Clark County Library District, by and
3 through its attorneys of record, the law firm of Bailey❖Kennedy, hereby
4 stipulate and agree as follows:

5 1. Pursuant to this Court’s September 26, 2017 Order Granting the
6 Parties’ September 21, 2017 Stipulation, the time to file Respondent’s
7 Answering Brief was extended for a period of thirty (30) days from October 2,
8 2017, to November 1, 2017 and Appellant was granted an additional thirty (30)
9 days to file her Reply Brief, which is to be filed within sixty (60) days after
10 Respondent’s Answering Brief is served.

11 2. In September 2017, Kelly Stout, Esq. (“Ms. Stout”), the Library
12 District’s attorney who has been primarily responsible for the briefing and
13 day-to-day handling of this case, suffered a severe eye injury that has resulted
14 in a temporary, but significant impairment of her vision.

15 3. To allow Ms. Stout time to recover, the Parties stipulated to a
16 second extension of time for Respondent to file its Answering Brief.

17 4. On November 13, 2017, the Court granted the Parties’ stipulation
18 to extend the time to file Respondent’s Answering Brief for an additional

1 period of forty-five (45) days—from November 1, 2017 until December 15,
2 2017.

3 5. At the time the Parties submitted their second request for an
4 extension, Ms. Stout’s recovery time was expected to last three to five weeks.

5 6. However, Ms. Stout’s recovery is taking longer than expected.
6 At this time, it is expected that Ms. Stout will require an additional two to
7 three weeks of treatment before steps can be taken to restore her vision.

8 7. In order to accommodate Ms. Stout’s ongoing treatment and
9 recovery, the Parties stipulate and agree that the time to file Respondent’s
10 Answering Brief shall be extended for an additional period of thirty-one (31)
11 days from December 15, 2017 until January 15, 2017.
