ORDER IMPOSING TEMPORARY STAY AND DIRECTING ANSWER


This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus and/or prohibition challenging a district court minute order setting an evidentiary hearing for March 8, 2017, and declaring NRS 1.310 unconstitutional. Within the petition, petitioner has demonstrated that a temporary stay of the district court proceedings is warranted. *See* NRAP 8(d). Accordingly, the proceedings in Eighth Judicial District Court Case No. D-16-543167-D are hereby temporarily stayed pending further order of this court.

Additionally, having considered the petition, it appears that an answer to the petition will assist this court in resolving this matter. Therefore, real party in interest, on behalf of respondents, shall have 30 days from the date of this order within which to file an answer, including

authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. Petitioner shall have 15 days from service of the answer to file and serve any reply.
