Introduction

Respondent, Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. ("Wells Fargo" or "Respondent"), by and through its counsel of record, the law firm of Snell & Wilmer L.L.P., hereby moves, *unopposed*, for an extension of time to file its Answering Brief. The Brief is currently due to be filed on November 6, 2017. Wells Fargo respectfully requests an extension until December 6, 2017, pursuant to NRAP 27 and NRAP 31(b).

This is Wells Fargo's second request for an extension; one previous extension of time has been sought and one has been granted. Wells Fargo respectfully requests a second extension because of the recent and serious illness of the undersigned counsel.

Analysis

Wells Fargo seeks a second extension of time to file its Answering Brief because of illness of counsel. Undersigned counsel became ill on Monday, October 9, 2017, and was incorrectly diagnosed with influenza two days later, on Wednesday, October 11, 2017. Counsel had a continuous high fever from October 9 for more than eleven days, at which point she was admitted to the hospital and eventually diagnosed with a rare form of double pneumonia. Counsel was hospitalized for

five days, through October 23, 2017. Counsel was released by her doctor to return to work on a reduced schedule on October 30, 2017. Due to the severity of this illness, counsel has been almost entirely unable to work for three weeks leading up to the due date of the Answering Brief, and is on a restricted schedule until her full recovery is confirmed.

Wells Fargo does not seek an extension for any improper purpose, or for the purpose of delay. Additionally, an extension of time will not prejudice the parties. Finally, Daisy Trust's counsel has explicitly consented to Wells Fargo's requested extension.

Conclusion

Based upon the foregoing, Wells Fargo respectfully requests that the Court grants its Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Answering Brief, allowing it up to and including December 6, 2017 to file its Answering Brief.
