*ORDER GRANTING MOTION*

On March 1, 2018, amicus curiae filed a motion to associate attorney Elliott C. Mogul of the law firm of Arnold & Porter Kaye Scholer LLP, in this matter pursuant to SCR 42. Attached to the motion to associate Mr. Mogul is a verified application, certificates of good standing from the District of Columbia and the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court of New York, and a Supreme Court Rule 42 statement.
