(together, the “VIPI Parties”), and Respondents Marshal S. Willick and Willick

1 Law Group (together, the “Willick Parties”), by and through their respective
2 counsel, stipulate and agree, pursuant to NRAP 31(b)(2), to extend the briefing
3 schedule deadline as follows:

4 1. On April 3, 2017, the VIPI Parties filed and served their Notice
5 of Appeal, which was docketed with this Court on April 10, 2017;

6 2. On May 9, 2017, this Court entered its Order Removing from
7 Settlement Program and Reinstating Briefing, providing that the VIPI Parties
8 shall have 90 days to file and serve their Opening Brief and Appendix;

9 3. On May 15, 2017, the VIPI Parties filed and served their
10 Docketing Statement – Civil Appeals;

11 4. On August 2, 2017, this Court entered its Order Granting
12 Telephonic Extension, providing that the VIPI Parties shall have until August
13 21, 2017, to file and serve their Opening Brief and Appendix;

14 5. On August 21, 2017, the VIPI Parties filed and served their
15 Opening Brief and Appendix;

16 6. Pursuant to NRAP 31(a)(1)(B), the Willick Parties presently have
17 until September 20, 2017 to file and serve their Answering Brief;

1 7. Due to scheduling conflicts for the Willick Parties' counsel and
2 the upcoming Jewish holidays, the Willick Parties seek a 30 day continuance,
3 which the VIPI Parties agree to, so that the Willick Parties shall now have
4 until October 20, 2017 to file and serve their Answering Brief;

5 8. The instant 30-day extension is within the total amount of days
6 allowed under NRAP 31(b)(2) for extending the deadline for filing any brief;

7 9. Good cause exists for the above extension, and this is the first
8 request by the Willick Parties to extend the briefing deadline as outlined
9 above; and

10 10. This stipulation is entered into in good faith by all the parties and
11 is not intended to delay these proceedings.
