ORDER

On March 23, 2018, this court entered an order directing counsel for respondent, Radford Smith and Gary Silverman, to show cause regarding their failure to file the fast track response; and to demonstrate why they should not pay additional monetary sanctions and/or be referred to the State Bar for investigation.

Mr. Smith has filed a timely response to this court's order. In his response, Mr. Smith makes clear that Mr. Silverman has had no involvement in the instant appeal since its inception. Accordingly, no sanction is imposed on Mr. Silverman.

Mr. Smith explains that a confluence of events, described as a "perfect storm," converged upon him during the time the fast track response in this matter was due, causing him to miss the filing deadline. Based on Mr. Smith's response to this court's order, we are persuaded that further sanction beyond \$500 is inappropriate. Accordingly, Mr. Smith shall have

15 days from the date of this order to pay the sum of \$500 to the Supreme Court Law Library and provide this court with proof of such payment.

It is so ORDERED.
