Ms. Premsrirut argued that there is no conflict, and advised that conflict waivers were reached. Upon Court's inquiry, Ms. Premsrirut advised that Mr. Fink is unable to appear today, but she was under the impression from the Dept. that his presence would be waived as long as one attorney was present. Court generally requires all counsel who wish to be associated to appear.

Mr. Nersesian acknowledges that a conflict of waiver was signed, but argued that there appears to be an impropriety concerning representation of the Defts which may impact disciplinary rules. Mr. Nersesian also objected to the format of the affidavit.

Argument by Mr. Muller.

Upon review of the signed waiver of conflict, COURT ORDERED, motion is GRANTED. COURT ADMONISHED, out of State counsel are expected to abide by Nevada rules and rules of the Department. They are to appear at major hearings and motion practice, and may not conduct depositions or take other actions without the presence of Nevada local counsel. Local counsel are also to sign off any pleadings or briefs submitted by out of State counsel to the Court.

DEFTS' MTN TO DISMISS PURSUANT TO NRS 41.635-41.670 (NEVADA ANTI SLAPP STATUTE) :

Statement by the Court on its' interpretation of the Anti-Slapp Statute. Court believes this to be a case of litigation privilege; the issue being whether Deft. Frank was acting as an attorney. Mr. Muller confirmed that the Deft. is an attorney licensed to practice in California. So stipulated by Mr. Nersesian.

Mr. Muller argued that there is no evidence statements made were false and, although there is no Nevada case law dealing with this issue, maintains there is ample case law in other jurisdictions.

Colloquy as to whether intentional torts come within the litigation privilege, and if the Anti-Slapp Statute deals with the right to petition.

Mr. Nersesian contends the litigation privilege does not apply, there was no litigation or expectation of litigation at the time the tort occurred and the law suit concerns allegations Deft. Frank was acting in his own personal interests and committed the tort of procurement by instigating termination of the contract. Mr. Nersesian believes there is also an issue of whether a foreign attorney can claim litigation privilege.

COURT FINDS, the Anti-Slapp Statute in Nevada applies and ORDERED, motion to dismiss is DENIED. FURTHER, request for attorney's fees and costs is also DENIED.

DEFTS' MTN TO DISMISS PLTF'S COMPLAINT FOR FAILURE TO STATE CLAIMS AGAINST DEFTS :

Based upon the complaint and pleadings submitted, COURT FINDS, Deft. Frank was serving as an attorney when he communicated with the Defts, the litigation privilege applies in California or Nevada and ORDERED, motion is GRANTED. COURT CLARIFIED, the complaint is dismissed as to the 2nd and 3rd causes of action involving DEFT FRANK.

DEFT'S MTN TO STRIKE PORTIONS OF PLTF'S COMPLAINT :

Argument by Mr. Muller. Colloquy as to whether breach of contract justifies punitive damages. COURT ORDERED, motion is GRANTED. Mr. Nersesian clarified that he did not attempt to sue Deft. Dales for punitive damages. COURT CLARIFIED, any punitive damage claims against the talent Defts (DALE, MAYER & RICK'S RESTORATION) are STRICKEN.

Argument by Mr. Jaffe in support of relief requested, stating there was not sufficient time for Plaintiff to conduct the necessary proceedings, and there was no discovery in this case. Mr. Muller opposed, noting Mr. Phillips testimony will do nothing different in this case, and there was no excusable negligent. COURT STATED ITS FINDINGS and ORDERED, Plaintiff's Motion for Rehearing and Reconsideration of Defendants' Richard J. Dale, Kelly Mayer, and Rick's Restorations, Inc.'s Motion for Summary Judgment DENIED; and Defendant Richard Dale's, Defendant Kelly Mayer's, and Defendant Rick's Restorations, Inc.'s Joint Motion to Strike the Affidavit of Clinton Billups Accompanying Plaintiff Irwin Gonor's Motion for Rehearing and Reconsideration of Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment DENIED.

Following further argument by counsel, COURT FURTHER ORDERED. Defendants Richard J. Dale, Kelly Mayer and Rick's Restorations, Inc.'s Motion to Strike Portions of Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint DENIED.

Court NOTED, it was not aware of the other motions. Counsel stipulated to submit the oral argument and matter be taken under advisement.

As to Defendants Richard J. Dale, Kelly Mayer and Rick's Restorations, Inc.'s Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint for Failure to State Claims Against Defendants, Mr. Muller argued that pursuant to the Court prior rulings regarding the Motion for Summary Judgment and Motion for Rehearing and Reconsideration, this Court should dismiss the case with leave to amend. Mr. Jaffe opposed, noting the issues pleaded in the Amended Complaint are outside the scope of the

Motion for Summary Judgment, it contains vicarious liability, and Plaintiff has properly pleaded. COURT ADDITIONALLY ORDERED, Motion is taken UNDER ADVISEMENT.

With respect to Defendants, Gold & Silver Pawn Shop, Inc., Richard Kevin Harrison and Richard Corey Harrison's Motion to Dismiss, Mr. Gerrard argued his clients' statements of opinion did not constitute as a defamatory statements under Nevada law. Mr. Jaffe opposed, Plaintiff pleaded the elements of defamation with supporting facts, Defendants' conducts and statements imputed damages to Plaintiff and affected his business negatively, and Plaintiff fulfilled the pleading requirements. COURT ORDERED, matter taken UNDER ADVISEMENT.

Mr. Larson argued in support of Defendants William Morris Endeavor Entertainment, LLC, Sean Perry and Amir Shahkhalili's Motion to Sever Plaintiff Irwin Gonor's Claims Against Defendants Richard Kevin Harrison, Richard Corey Harrison and Gold & Silver Pawn Shop, Inc. COURT FURTHER ORDERED, Motion and its Joinders thereto are taken UNDER ADVISEMENT.

- On June 26, 2014, the Honorable Nancy A. Becker, Senior District Judge, heard argument on several motions in this case. The Court ruled on some of the motions and the remaining motions were taken under advisement after oral argument. Upon review of the minutes of June 26, 2014, the Court notes an error in the minutes with regard to one of the motions - specifically Defendants Dale, Mayer and Rick's Restoration Motion to Strike Punitive Damages. The minutes reflect the motion was denied in its entirety. This is inaccurate. The Court denied the motion in part and granted it in part. The Court noted punitive damages were not available as a matter of law in Plaintiff's contract and quasi-contractual claim and any punitive damages claims were linked to any tort claims. With respect to the motions that were taken under advisement, the Court sets forth its decisions below.

Defendants' Dale, Mayer and Rick's Restoration Motion to Dismiss the First, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Causes of Action in the First Amended Complaint. The motion is DENIED IN PART and GRANTED IN PART. Many of the factual allegations and actions are an attempt to revive claims that were dismissed by summary judgment on August 29, 2013. Any amended complaint should have been limited to the claims that were remaining after the granting of summary judgment, not a restatement of the dismissed claims with additional facts. The remaining claims are not cognizable at

law. Specifically:

1. The First claim - Breach of Contract - was limited by the summary judgment to breach of a contract allegedly established on August 26, 2011 and ending on October 31, 2011 for services performed by Plaintiff under a temporary agency agreement. Any claim beyond that is STRICKEN and the motion is GRANTED WITH PREJUDICE as to allegations that final agency agreement was created on August 26, 2011. Should Plaintiff prevail on the temporary agency contract theory, then any damages are those which Plaintiff can prove pursuant to contract law relating to the breach of that agreement.

2. The Fifth claim - Unjust Enrichment - this is a quasi-contractual claim plead in the alternative in the event Plaintiff cannot prove the Breach of Contract claim. As with the Breach of Contract claim, it is limited to the time period August 26, 2011 to October 31, 2011. To the extent that the allegations go beyond this time period, they are STRICKEN and the motion is GRANTED WITH PREJUDICE as to those allegations.

3. The Sixth claim - Detrimental Reliance - this is a theory of liability, not a cause of action and it is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

4. The Seventh claim - Quantum Merit - this is a quasi-contractual claim plead in the alternative in the event Plaintiff cannot prove the Breach of Contract claim. As with the Breach of Contract claim, it is limited to the time period August 26, 2011 to October 31, 2011. To the extent that the allegations go beyond this time period, they are STRICKEN and the motion is GRANTED WITH PREJUDICE as to those allegations.

5. The Eighth claim - Vicarious Liability - this is a theory of liability and not a cause of action. It is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE. However, Plaintiff may amend the First Amended Complaint to add this theory of liability against Rick's Restoration in the factual assertion at the beginning of the Complaint.

Counsel for Defendants Dale, etc. shall prepare the order on this motion and submit it to opposing counsel for review pursuant to the applicable court rules.

Defendants Gold & Silver Pawn Shop, Richard and Corey Harrison Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Defamation claim is GRANTED WITH PREJUDICE. The statements listed in the complaint are pure opinion and there is nothing about the place or manner in which they were stated that suggests a mixed question of opinion and factual assertion. Even assuming the Harrisons' made the statements attributed to them, they are not factual assertions or a statement of opinion that suggests a factual basis unfavorable to Plaintiff exists for their refusal to work with him. Thus the statements are not defamatory as a matter of law and the claim fails to state a cause of action. As this resolves all claims against these defendants and the claims are separate and distinct from the remaining claims and parties in the case, the request for NRCP 54(b) certification is GRANTED. Counsel for Gold & Silver,

etc. shall prepare the order and submit it to the opposing counsel for review.

William Morris Endeavor, Perry and Shahkhalili Defendants' Motion to Sever the Harrison Defamation Action is MOOT in light of the Court's decision to dismiss those claims. William Morris counsel shall prepare the order on this motion and submit to opposing counsel for review.

Disposition on the various motions includes any party that joined in the motions.

Additionally, Ms. Hanlon stated there is nothing in any document that says there is going to be an ongoing entitlement to a 10% commission on merchandise sales. The Defts' agree Pltf. is owed some money for commission on sales that occurred during the three month period which is about \$5,000.00 and not an amount that would warrant jurisdiction by the Court. As to the third and fourth causes of action, Ms. Hanlon argued there is no issue that there is quasi contractual issues here because that would be premised on there being a contract which there is not. Further, punitive damages were previously stricken as to the contractual and now striking them as to the tortious. Ms. Hanlon believes the parties need to go to a settlement conference with these rulings firmly in place so it can be determined as to what Pltf. is owed for the three month period of time. Additional argument by Mr. Alexander. Court stated there are two separate issues that need to be bifurcated. If counsel can satisfy his burden and the jury agrees with counsel with respect as to whether or not there was a contract agreement for Pltf. and only if at that point, the Court will give counsel opportunity to present additional evidence with an expert to support Pltf would be entitled to future commissions.
