1        LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, MONDAY, MARCH 20, 2017, 9:48 A.M.

2                THE COURT: State of Nevada v. Willis Tyrone Brown,  
3 C-319125. Okay. Is the defendant here? The Defendant's  
4 present. He's out of custody. He's represented by Mr.  
5 Modafferi. This is Pretrial Writ of Habeas Corpus filed by  
6 the defendant in this matter. Who is here on behalf of the  
7 State?

8                MS. CLEMONS: Jennifer Clemons for the State.

9                THE COURT: Mr. Modafferi, the argument that you're  
10 making, the main argument that I see is with respect to Counts  
11 4 and 5.

12               MR. MODAFFERI: That's correct, Judge.

13               THE COURT: Your position is, is that the JP in this  
14 matter, in reviewing the case, had somewhat bled over all the  
15 facts of the other incidents and took those into consideration  
16 for purposes of 4 and 5, right?

17               MR. MODAFFERI: That's one -- one way of stating it.  
18 Yes, Judge.

19               THE COURT: Okay. In reading the transcript myself,  
20 independent of the other, you have -- you have your client in  
21 the position that he's in, with the Boys Club -- Boys and  
22 Girls Club of America.

23               MR. MODAFFERI: Right, Judge. Never being in  
24 trouble before in his entire life.

25               THE COURT: No, I understand.

1 MR. MODAFFERI: Yeah.

2 THE COURT: But under the circumstances, with just I  
3 guess it's HH, is it -- I think that's the --

4 MS. CLEMONS: That's the victim --

5 MR. MODAFFERI: The HH --

6 MS. CLEMONS: -- yeah, for that --

7 MR. MODAFFERI: -- yeah.

8 THE COURT: Is that number 4 and 5 --

9 MS. CLEMONS: Yes.

10 MR. MODAFFERI: Yes, Judge.

11 THE COURT: -- HH? Yeah, is that he -- I  
12 understand, and the other ones with -- based on his language  
13 as a -- you know, he's saying things like, you know, are you  
14 still a virgin, when you lost your virginity did you like it,  
15 you know -- you know, did it hurt, can I touch you like -- you  
16 know, things like that.

17 I understand that with the other -- and I understand  
18 the argument is that there's a prejudicial effect of hearing  
19 those facts in conjunction with just a -- and if HH stood  
20 alone, we wouldn't know about those unless obviously the State  
21 said we need a prior bad act motion to allow the -- them to  
22 consider that for -- is that not similar under 48.045, is that  
23 -- is that the trier of fact can consider that in light of the  
24 case -- in light of the factual scenario in this case of all  
25 of it together, because of the -- under the -- under the --

1 independent of the State staying, Judge, we want you to hear  
2 this independent evidence as a prior bad act under 48.045, it  
3 was presented that way. And then Court then makes a  
4 determination independent of their motion. Isn't that what  
5 happens?

6 MR. MODAFFERI: Not in this case, Judge. And let me  
7 explain why.

8 THE COURT: Okay.

9 MR. MODAFFERI: These counts need to be considered  
10 separately on their own merit. And, you know, Judge Bixler,  
11 Magistrate Bixler, he understood that point when he said,  
12 counsel, I do not disagree with you about the fact that I need  
13 to consider these counts separately.

14 THE COURT: Um-hum.

15 MR. MODAFFERI: Innately, he knew that, you know,  
16 Black Letter Law through law school, through jury  
17 instructions, through telling people that you can't borrow  
18 evidence from one count in order to find someone guilty of  
19 another.

20 And he said to me, basically this, "Here is my take  
21 on this. And this is kind of troubling, Counsel. You are not  
22 incorrect." I guess a back-handed way of saying, you're  
23 right. "These counts have to be considered separately and  
24 independently based on evidence provided on each of the  
25 counts. I've got to tell you, the Counts involving HH are not

1 very strong, they're not very strong at all."

2 THE COURT: Um-hum.

3 MR. MODAFFERI: "When you take the testimony of that  
4 little 12-year old girl completely isolated by itself, it  
5 wouldn't amount to squat in terms of criminal conduct."

6 THE COURT: Um-hum.

7 MR. MODAFFERI: So he tells us, you know what, I'm  
8 going to take a pass on this and bounce it up to Justice Court  
9 and let Judge Kephart deal with it.

10 THE COURT: You mean, District Court, um-hum.

11 MR. MODAFFERI: And you know what I'm going to do?  
12 I'm going to borrow a little evidence off of Counts 3. And  
13 I'm saying, Judge, you can't borrow evidence off of Counts --

14 THE COURT: Well, but that --

15 MR. MODAFFERI: -- 3 -- Counts 3 -- Count 3 didn't  
16 even happen. We've got an independent witness who said that  
17 that woman in -- that girl in Count 3 didn't even go into his  
18 office.

19 THE COURT: Well, no, independent --

20 MR. MODAFFERI: You know what I'm saying? We're  
21 getting into a trap where we're borrowing evidence where  
22 evidence shouldn't be borrowed from. And then all of a sudden  
23 we have a total breakdown in due process, and he's not getting  
24 a reliable judgment as to Counts 4 and 5. We don't have no  
25 Petrocelli hearing to determine whether or not this stuff

1 should come in.

2 THE COURT: I know. That's what I'm talking about  
3 under 48.045 -- 045. It's different though when a Judge is  
4 determining that versus when --

5 MR. MODAFFERI: I know, but that -- he --

6 THE COURT: -- versus --

7 MR. MODAFFERI: -- he made us -- a record --

8 THE COURT: And so --

9 MR. MODAFFERI: -- for us. He said, these counts  
10 shouldn't go up unless I do borrow.

11 THE COURT: Um-hum. Well, I know, so he's make --

12 MR. MODAFFERI: And then he sends them up.

13 THE COURT: -- so he's making the determination that  
14 it's -- that crimes, wrongs or act is not -- is not  
15 inadmissible, is what he's finding, based on what he's heard.  
16 And the time frame of when this has occurred, it allows the  
17 Judge -- it allows a trier of fact to make that determination  
18 based on the time frame that they could consider the other --  
19 other information.

20 MR. MODAFFERI: It emasculates what we tell jurors  
21 in every case. I mean, look at the Binion --

22 THE COURT: Well, I --

23 MR. MODAFFERI: -- look at the Binion case, you  
24 know, I cited that --

25 THE COURT: -- Mr. Modafferi, I --



1 MR. MODAFFERI: -- in my -- yeah.

2 THE COURT: -- I understand your argument  
3 completely. I want to hear from the State and see how they  
4 consider that.

5 MR. MODAFFERI: Okay.

6 THE COURT: Let's --

7 MS. CLEMONS: Thank you, Your Honor. You know, so  
8 my memory of kind of how things went down in Justice Court is  
9 slightly different. When we were initially talking about  
10 amending the Complaint --

11 THE COURT: Um-hum.

12 MS. CLEMONS: -- with regards to the Counts for HH,  
13 that's when the Justice of the Peace got -- had some concern  
14 about the intent element for the conduct with HH. And then I  
15 went through and explained, even if you had her on her own --

16 THE COURT: Meaning, the intent element of the  
17 defendant with regard --

18 MS. CLEMONS: Yes, with HH.

19 THE COURT: Okay. And that's --

20 MS. CLEMONS: I said even if you --

21 THE COURT: -- 48.045 --

22 MS. CLEMONS: Yeah.

23 THE COURT: -- that's right there.

24 MS. CLEMONS: Yeah. And -- but -- and even without  
25 that, I mean, the fact that he -- this happens more than one

1 time that his --

2 THE COURT: Right.

3 MS. CLEMONS: -- hand lingers on her thigh and  
4 brushes up against her chest, she was a very young-looking 12-  
5 year old girl. She's not the kind of girl that you're going  
6 to ask, oh, are you still a virgin and did it hurt when you  
7 had sex the first time, because she does not appear to be of  
8 an -- of a child who would be engaging in those types of  
9 activities whereas the other two girls are older and had  
10 boyfriends and things like that.

11 But additionally, as I laid out in my Opposition or  
12 my Return, you know, intent is an element where we can look at  
13 the facts and circumstances surrounding it --

14 THE COURT: Um-hum.

15 MS. CLEMONS: -- and because of the time frame and  
16 because of the similarity in the conduct, it all happens at  
17 the Boys and Girls Club, the State's position would be that  
18 under 48.045, section (2) and section (3) which specifically  
19 deals with sexual intent, that those other facts could be  
20 considered for the HH counts.

21 THE COURT: How do we deal with it, though, in front  
22 of a jury, you know what I mean? Because --

23 MS. CLEMONS: Right.

24 THE COURT: -- because obviously you understand that  
25 you would have to request of the Court to determine whether or

1 not there was a -- you have to look at the prejudice value.  
2 But is it -- is it under (3) now, 48.045(3) that it's -- that  
3 it's just simply -- is it your position that it's simply  
4 admissible?

5 MS. CLEMONS: That's -- that's the State's position  
6 on how we're reading subsection (3).

7 THE COURT: Yeah.

8 MS. CLEMONS: It's inadmissible for propensity  
9 purposes. So you can consider it for intent. But, I mean, if  
10 they find that there wasn't -- say they find HH is incredible  
11 and they don't think --

12 THE COURT: Yeah.

13 MS. CLEMONS: -- that what she says is true, then  
14 they -- I mean, they're not going to find him guilty on those  
15 counts. So she still has present -- or we still have to prove  
16 the other --

17 THE COURT: Right.

18 MS. CLEMONS: -- elements of that -- of that  
19 offense. It's just the intent portion of it.

20 THE COURT: Mr. Modafferi, when you look at  
21 48.045(3), I mean, that's the amended -- they added --

22 MR. MODAFFERI: I know that, Judge. Yeah.

23 THE COURT: It specifically says, "This section  
24 shall not be construed to prohibit the admission of evidence  
25 in a criminal prosecution for sexual offense that a person

1 committed another crime, wrong or act that constitute a  
2 separate sexual offense as used in this subsection. Sexual  
3 offense has the meaning described," and then you know based on  
4 what's alleged here. So it sounds to me that --

5 MR. MODAFFERI: So, I don't think we --

6 THE COURT: -- I mean, that's --

7 MR. MODAFFERI: -- I don't think, Judge, we have  
8 evolved in our criminal justice system when we allow evidence  
9 to come in for propensity where --

10 THE COURT: No --

11 MR. MODAFFERI: -- you know, in this case --

12 THE COURT: Well, no, no, no, no, no, that  
13 particular statute, that change specifically does that.

14 MR. MODAFFERI: Listen, this is my point on that,  
15 okay, Judge?

16 THE COURT: Okay.

17 MR. MODAFFERI: We got -- we got this incident, what  
18 I deem, incidental conduct. He goes to hug the girl. And,  
19 you know, he hugs a lot of kids that are in stress at that  
20 place like he's been doing for 20 years since he's been a  
21 coach and a counselor without incident.

22 Then all of a sudden, at the end of August of 2016,  
23 these three girls come together at one point in time and say,  
24 oh, he touched me inappropriately. He touched my thigh. He  
25 touched the side of my body, my upper torso. It constitutes

1 an A felony. He could go to jail fo 35 to life.

2 All right. So how do we get that? Well, we get  
3 that not because he swiped up her leg and touched the side of  
4 her rib cage, we get that from Count 3. Well, Count 3 -- and  
5 we put on evidence at the Preliminary Hearing -- is the girl  
6 said she's sitting behind a computer desk and he said -- he  
7 said, "Can I touch your leg," and he touched her leg. And she  
8 giggled.

9 And then they went into the back office and they had  
10 sexual talk. And the Judge says, well, I can think about that  
11 when I'm considering this incidental conduct which amounts to  
12 Class A Felonies which will put you away for 35 to life.

13 MS. CLEMONS: It's 10 to life, actually --

14 MR. MODAFFERI: Well, 10 to life --

15 MS. CLEMONS: -- is the --

16 MR. MODAFFERI: -- excuse me -- and I'm going to do  
17 it by considering the conversation that he had with this girl  
18 in the office. So Alexander Guerrero (phonetic), an  
19 independent, unbiased staff worker says, I saw the whole  
20 incident. I was ten feet away from it. They never got two  
21 feet from each other. They were ten feet apart from each  
22 other during the entire time, from 7:02 to 7:14.

23 THE COURT: So your argument is, independent of what  
24 -- okay, so Judge Bixler says, I'm borrowing it from this --  
25 the intent issue --

1 MR. MODAFFERI: Right.

2 THE COURT: -- but you're saying, that evidence was  
3 no good, because we had another witness that said it was no  
4 good.

5 MR. MODAFFERI: Well, that's what happens, this  
6 domino effect occurs --

7 THE COURT: Yeah, but --

8 MR. MODAFFERI: -- and then all of sudden the whole  
9 probable cause determination is unreliable because we're  
10 borrowing it from here, and borrowing from there, and we're  
11 just assuming since the statute's in effect, propensity  
12 evidence.

13 THE COURT: Yeah, but it sounds -- it sounds like  
14 the Judge --

15 MR. MODAFFERI: Bad -- he was a bad dude --

16 THE COURT: -- it sounds like the --

17 MR. MODAFFERI: -- as President Trump would say.  
18 He's a bad dude. Do you know what I'm saying? That's not  
19 good enough.

20 THE COURT: It sounds like --

21 MR. MODAFFERI: We can't --

22 THE COURT: It sounds like the JP, though, made a  
23 determination as to the -- as to the credibility or the  
24 strength of the case with regards to the evidence in Count 3,  
25 and openly told you, that I'm going to consider that for

1 purposes of Count 4 and 5, because it shows the intent of your  
2 client. And that's -- I don't know how else to make -- I  
3 mean, that -- do you disagree? That's exactly what he says.

4 MR. MODAFFERI: Not the intent, Judge. His -- his  
5 words were, when it comes to quote/unquote, "criminal conduct,  
6 the State doesn't have squat."

7 THE COURT: Okay. But he bound it up.

8 MR. MODAFFERI: How do you get over that?

9 THE COURT: So he binds it up and says, Judge  
10 Kephart, I find there's nothing to support it, but I'm going  
11 to bind it up on that anyhow?

12 MR. MODAFFERI: Yes. Isn't that wrong? I don't  
13 think it's right either, Judge.

14 THE COURT: I don't think that --

15 MR. MODAFFERI: Why should you be --

16 THE COURT: I don't think that's what --

17 MR. MODAFFERI: -- put in the place to put it --

18 THE COURT: I don't think that's what happened, Mr.  
19 Modafferi. I don't see --

20 MR. MODAFFERI: I do.

21 THE COURT: -- that.

22 MR. MODAFFERI: I really do. I feel like he felt  
23 like --

24 THE COURT: I don't -- the record --

25 MR. MODAFFERI: -- let Judge Kephart short this out.

1           THE COURT: -- doesn't support that. The record  
2 doesn't support that, Mr. Modafferi. He found that there was  
3 sufficient evidence to hold him to answer to all counts. But  
4 he did comment that with regards to 4 and 5, it was slim, with  
5 the exception of the intent element that he derived from his  
6 actions and his comments in the other case -- in the other  
7 counts, that are associated with the other counts. That's how  
8 I see it. That's -- so --

9           MR. MODAFFERI: How does that work? I mean, I don't  
10 mean to sound -- Judge, I don't mean to sound pedantic about  
11 this, but how does that actually work in a legal analysis?  
12 You've got two counts that, according to the Judge, are  
13 worthless, unless you look at the other counts. And then you  
14 look at the other counts, and we present evidence that they're  
15 not worth --

16           THE COURT: Right. Let --

17           MR. MODAFFERI: -- looking at.

18           THE COURT: -- let me give you --

19           MR. MODAFFERI: Okay.

20           THE COURT: -- in a scenario like this.

21           MR. MODAFFERI: Yeah.

22           THE COURT: Let's say your client was already  
23 charged with Counts 1 through 3, and he gets convicted of  
24 them. Or even if he doesn't get convicted of them, but  
25 there's evidence to support the claims of what's being said as



1 a prior bad act; okay?

2 Four and five come later, because the young -- the  
3 young girl says, you know what, he did this stuff to me, too,  
4 the young -- HH comes forward after the fact. And he's  
5 already been through the process on the other. Everyone knows  
6 about his actions on 1, 2 and 3; all right?

7 HH comes forward and says, you know what, I think he  
8 was doing this stuff to me, too. The State now says, you know  
9 what, Judge -- HH, we agree with you, because we can tell  
10 based on his actions in 1, 2 and 3.

11 So they charge just Counts 4 and 5. You come in and  
12 say, Judge, there's absolutely nothing here to support it. In  
13 their case -- in that case, though, if they just presented HH  
14 by herself, they'd probably have a harder time, because  
15 there's no evidence of 1, 2 and 3.

16 But if they present it to the JP and said, Judge, we  
17 need you to consider 1, 2 and 3, these actions as well, as  
18 prior bad acts under 48.045. The Judge then takes into  
19 consideration 1, 2 and 3 and says, you know what, I agree with  
20 you. His intent's clear to me.

21 His intent is that he's messing with these young  
22 girls and that's what his plans are. And he's already -- he's  
23 already showed it in 1, 2 and 3. And so that's what -- so I'm  
24 going to use that to bind up on 4 and 5. That's the scenario.  
25 Basically, what you're saying, but they had it all together at

1 one time.

2 So now the JP didn't have to determine 1, 2 and 3  
3 independently, because he was hearing it all at one time.  
4 Okay?

5 MR. MODAFFERI: So then does that put you in the  
6 position of reviewing the record and looking at Count 1 --

7 THE COURT: Well, I have to.

8 MR. MODAFFERI: Okay. Okay.

9 THE COURT: Every time I look -- every time I look  
10 at a Writ that you bring to me, or anyone brings to -- a Writ,  
11 I've got to look at the full record to determine whether or  
12 not the Judge had sufficient evidence for purposes, slight or  
13 marginal, to hold him to answer.

14 And that's why I -- I got into 48.045, because  
15 that's the only way I could think of. And when he made that  
16 comment, that I've got to take from the other case to show  
17 that, he was saying, I believe 4 and 5's weak, but when I know  
18 what his intent is, okay, and coupled with that, I have --  
19 there's sufficient evidence for a bindover. That's how I look  
20 at it.

21 MR. MODAFFERI: So if we're going to do the sort of  
22 shell game where we're borrowing evidence from counts, let's  
23 do -- let's --

24 THE COURT: Okay.

25 MR. MODAFFERI: -- go through the full analysis.

1 Count 1, the girl said she originally thought it was an  
2 accident.

3 THE COURT: Um-hum.

4 MR. MODAFFERI: And she didn't think it was anything  
5 until Count 2 happened.

6 THE COURT: Yeah. Well --

7 MR. MODAFFERI: So Count 1 is potentially an  
8 accident, and Count 3, according to Alexander --

9 THE COURT: Well, but she codified it. She codified  
10 it.

11 MS. CLEMONS: Yeah.

12 THE COURT: She says, yeah, you know, the first time  
13 he didn't, it didn't really get me. But when he did it again,  
14 and when -- and what he did the second time, I know what he  
15 was -- it wasn't -- she did it herself. She cleared it up  
16 herself, okay? So --

17 MR. MODAFFERI: So, I understand what the Court's  
18 saying. But then we go to Count 3, which is a separate  
19 victim, one count --

20 THE COURT: Yeah.

21 MR. MODAFFERI: -- and she says this happens behind  
22 the desk of the Boys Club and Girls Club of America --

23 THE COURT: Um-hum.

24 MR. MODAFFERI: -- and the woman says, now, I  
25 watched them the entire 12 minutes from 7:02 to 7:14. And we

1 put in all of these attendance logs which show he's checking  
2 people in left and right. Families are coming, paying their  
3 bills, he's logging them into the computer. It's during this  
4 12 minute period, in public view, that he allegedly sexually  
5 assaults this girl and then takes her into the back room and  
6 has conversation, asks her straight up. It's unrebutted  
7 evidence. Did he ever go in that office with her? No, it  
8 never happened.

9 THE COURT: He actually -- it wasn't --

10 MR. MODAFFERI: He never went into that office.

11 THE COURT: -- a -- it wasn't a sexual assault, it  
12 was a sexual assault, it was a lewdness.

13 MR. MODAFFERI: A lewdness, I -- well, I --

14 THE COURT: But there's a big difference, Mr.  
15 Modafferi.

16 MR. MODAFFERI: A molestation.

17 MS. CLEMONS: Yeah.

18 MR. MODAFFERI: All right. A molestation.

19 THE COURT: So --

20 MR. MODAFFERI: Well, where he allegedly ran his  
21 finger up her thigh when they're ten feet apart.

22 THE COURT: And coupled --

23 MS. CLEMONS: Well --

24 THE COURT: -- with some --

25 MR. MODAFFERI: Coupled with some lascivious

1 language that occurred in the office --

2 THE COURT: Well --

3 MR. MODAFFERI: -- that they never entered according  
4 to the independent witness. So, I mean, we're borrowing  
5 evidence from --

6 THE COURT: Yeah, but --

7 MR. MODAFFERI: -- really --

8 THE COURT: Okay.

9 MR. MODAFFERI: -- desperate counts.

10 THE COURT: I know, but I have to --

11 MR. MODAFFERI: Slippery slope.

12 THE COURT: -- I have to look at -- I -- no, it --  
13 you know, and quite honestly, Mr. Modafferi, I think at this  
14 point in time, because of the standard, and what the -- the  
15 way the standard is, it's a hard road for the defense. I  
16 openly admit that.

17 Once it gets to this point, when I have a JP that's  
18 determining the evidence and watching the -- the testimony and  
19 determining the credibility and believability of witnesses,  
20 and under the circumstances of it, it is -- it's a tough --  
21 it's -- for me to look at just a bare record, you know, just a  
22 record with just -- with no emotion, that's hard. And so --

23 MR. MODAFFERI: I agree, Judge. So -- and I just  
24 wanted to make one last point.

25 THE COURT: -- and the standard is so slight.

1           MR. MODAFFERI: I want -- I wanted to make a point  
2 about that standard. And I heard another attorney argue  
3 before me about the standard and how he described it as being  
4 a scintilla. And I don't agree with that.

5           THE COURT: Okay.

6           MR. MODAFFERI: And I never have agreed with the  
7 fact that everyone emasculates the probable cause standard by  
8 calling it slight or marginal, even though the Supreme Court  
9 used that language in one case.

10           You know, the standard is still the same standard.  
11 It's probable cause. It's the amount of evidence that they  
12 need the government to get in your house, or to arrest you, or  
13 to tap your phones; it's probable cause.

14           And you still have to view it in that paradigm. You  
15 can't just because the Supreme Court has said slight or  
16 marginal at one point, describe it like the other attorney did  
17 as a scintilla. It's not.

18           And I think that in this jurisdiction where there is  
19 no Rule 29 motion, there's nothing to take from the trial  
20 Judge, the ability to sever these counts out because a prima  
21 facie case hasn't been made during trial, it's incumbent upon  
22 you, and it's incumbent upon the Grand Jury to exercise that  
23 independent shield against unwarranted charges.

24           THE COURT: Um-hum.

25           MR. MODAFFERI: And 4 and 5 obviously are toss-ins

1 that they're using. I understand their position. As a former  
2 prosecutor, I would have put them in for negotiating purposes.

3 MS. CLEMONS: No, that's not -- that's absolutely  
4 not true. The reason why 4 and 5 has that penalty is because  
5 of her age.

6 THE COURT: Yeah.

7 MS. CLEMONS: So, I mean, and that was amended  
8 because of her age. So, if he's -- if he's alluding to the  
9 fact that I add charges to just to deal --

10 MR. MODAFFERI: I didn't -- no, I didn't say --

11 MS. CLEMONS: -- that is not true --

12 MR. MODAFFERI: -- I didn't say -- not a comment on  
13 this prosecutor --

14 MS. CLEMONS: -- and offensive.

15 MR. MODAFFERI: -- at all.

16 MS. CLEMONS: Thank you.

17 MR. MODAFFERI: What I'm saying as a general  
18 practice, it's common.

19 THE COURT: I know. Anything further?

20 MS. CLEMONS: Nothing from the State.

21 MR. MODAFFERI: No, Judge.

22 THE COURT: All right. Mr. Modafferi, I think you  
23 kind of probably know where I was going with this based on --

24 MR. MODAFFERI: I do.

25 THE COURT: -- my position.

1 MR. MODAFFERI: I do.

2 THE COURT: But I do find that the Court can make a  
3 determination as to the prejudice value of it and the  
4 admissibility of it under 48.045, and that in this case, Judge  
5 Bixler did just that. So, I am finding there's sufficient  
6 evidence to hold the defendant to trial with regards to all  
7 four -- I mean, all five, six counts -- is that --

8 MR. MODAFFERI: Five, Judge.

9 THE COURT: Five counts. Let me see, one, two --  
10 yeah, one, two, three and four. And I'm denying your motion;  
11 okay? I'm denying the Writ.

12 MR. MODAFFERI: Thank you, Judge.

13 THE COURT: Okay.

14 MR. MODAFFERI: Thank you. I apologize -- I  
15 appreciate you listening to my arguments.

16 THE COURT: All right. That's -- Mr. Brown, we have  
17 a trial date scheduled for May 15th. May 10th is a Calendar  
18 Call, and a Pretrial Conference is scheduled for April 12th.  
19 So, I need you to be here on those days. Keep in contact with  
20 your attorney; okay?

21 THE DEFENDANT: Sure.

22 THE COURT: All right.







An investigator is necessary to serve subpoenas, obtain statements from witnesses, and generally investigate the circumstances of these allegations. Should the court approve this request for declaration of indigency, the Defendant will make specific requests through the county administrator. The consultation and possible testimony of Dr. Mark Chambers is necessary to fully understand and convey to both the court and/or the jury the influences upon a child's accusation in a sexual prosecution. The Defendant had been previously found to be indigent in Justice Court.

In Widdis, the Nevada Supreme Court held that a criminal defendant who has retained private counsel is nonetheless entitled to reasonable services at public expense based upon the defendant's showing indigency and need for the services.<sup>2</sup> The attached Application for Court – Appointed Counsel or Widdis Fees is sufficient proof for a declaration of indigency and judicial permission for the requested services.






