**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO

POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

NRAP 14(d) allows for an extension of time to file a docketing statement if good cause is shown. Although the docketing statement was filed a day late (and therefore rejected), good cause exists to extend time by two days so that it can be properly filed.

The docketing statement was due on May 30. Also due that day was the reply brief in another case before this Court (*Jablonski Enterprises, Ltd. v. Summa LLC*, docket number 71539). This reply brief was a consolidated reply to two separate answering briefs, and has taken up most of the undersigned's attention. In addition, the undersigned is a member of the legislative committee for Nevada Attorneys for Criminal Justice, a group which is heavily engaged in the ongoing legislative session. Since the session is slated to end in just five days, this is taking the remainder of the undersigned's time. The slight delay in filing the docketing statement was an oversight.

A two day extension of time would not prejudice this Court or the State. In addition, the docketing statement provides an important function for the Court (routing the case to its appropriate home) and the opposing party (notice of which issues may be argued). Extending time so that the docketing statement may be admitted would be a net positive for all parties involved. Mr. Franks therefore respectfully asks this Court to grant the extension of time and allow the docketing statement to be filed and accepted on June 1, 2017.
