ORDER TO FILE AMENDED DOCKETING STATEMENT

This is an appeal from an order granting a motion to dismiss in an action relating to real property. Appellants filed their docketing statement on August 8, 2017. However, it appears that the docketing statement may be incomplete. When matters have been consolidated in the district court, they become one case for all appellate purposes. *Mallin v. Farmers Ins. Exch.*, 106 Nev. 606, 609, 797 P.2d 978, 980 (1990). Thus, the docketing statement must include information and documentation relating to all cases that have been consolidated in the district court.

Here, appellants indicate that the judgment challenged on appeal was entered in a consolidated case consisting of district court case numbers 16 RP 00009 1B, 16 PBT 00107 1B, and 16 PBT 00108 1B. But the docketing statement does not contain information relating to the claims raised in case numbers 16 PBT 00107 1B, and 16 PBT 00108 1B and does not include copies of the complaints filed in those cases. In the absence of a

properly completed docketing statement, we are unable to determine if this appeal is properly before this court.

Appellants shall have 20 days from the date of this order to file and serve an amended docketing statement that answers all questions and attaches the documentation required by item 27 with respect to all of the consolidated district court cases. Failure to fully and accurately complete the docketing statement or attach all requested documentation may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. See NRAP 14(c).

It is so ORDERED.
