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Witter filed the instant petition and raised two claims: (1) the Nevada Supreme Court improperly reweighed Witter's eligibility for the death penalty by substituting the decision of the appellate court for the decision of the jury, and by failing to find the condition of eligibility beyond a reasonable doubt; and (2) Witter's death sentence is unconstitutional because the jury in his capital trial was not instructed that in order to find him eligible for the death penalty, it must have first found that the mitigation did not outweigh the statutory aggravating circumstances beyond a reasonable doubt.

On January 31, 2017, the State filed a response and motion to dismiss Witter's petition.

On May 31, 2017, the District Court, after finding that the prior Amended Judgment of Conviction entered against Witter was "not a final judgment" under <u>Whitehead v. State</u> and <u>Slaatte v. State</u>, granted the state's motion and denied the petition.

On or about June 30, 2017, Respondents submitted for the District Court's signature a Third (sic) Amended Judgment of Conviction.

Witter filed a timely first post-conviction petition which was denied by the district court after an evidentiary hearing and then affirmed on appeal by the Nevada Supreme Court in an unpublished order (SC# 36927). Remittitur issued on September 14, 2001. After litigating a federal habeas petition for several years, Witter returned to state court by filing a second state habeas petition on February 14, 2007. That petition was also denied and again affirmed on appeal by the Nevada Supreme Court in an unpublished order (SC# 50447). Witter also filed a third state habeas petition on April 28, 2008, which was also denied and affirmed on appeal (SC# 52964). Remittitur from this third habeas appeal issued on February 14, 2011. On January 11, 2017, Petition filed a fourth state habeas petition which raises a single issue based on Hurst v. Florida, 577 U.S. __, 136 S.Ct. 616 (2016). The State has filed a response and motion to dismiss the petition based on procedural default.

This Court finds that the instant petition, which is a fourth petition for a writ of habeas corpus by this Petitioner, is timely filed because the last Judgment of Conviction, although it does set a restitution amount, it also says an additional amount to be determined at a later date. Accordingly, it is not a final judgment and the time and procedural bars in NRS 34 never started to run. *See* Whitehead v. State, 128 Nev. ____, 285 P.3d 1053 (2012); Slaatte v. State, 129 Nev. ____, 298 P.3d 1170, 1171 (2013) ("Because the judgment of conviction contemplates restitution in an uncertain amount, it is not final and therefore is not appealable"). Therefore, the petition is not procedurally barred.

Turning to the merits of the issue, this Court finds that the capital proceedings in this case are consistent with <u>Apprendi</u>, <u>Ring</u>, and <u>Hurst</u>. *See* <u>Hurst v. Florida</u>, 577 U.S. __, 136 S.Ct. 616 (2016). First of all, both the eligibility and suitability were decided by a jury, not by the judge. And likewise, the Court doesn't find anything in <u>Hurst</u> that mandates that the weighing of aggravating and mitigating circumstances be done beyond a reasonable doubt. Accordingly, neither appellate reweighing nor the weighing process implicate <u>Hurst</u>. Because Petitioner has not demonstrated prejudice the petition is denied.
