MEMORANDUM

I, TALEEN PANDUKHT, am a duly licensed attorney in the State of Nevada and am employed by the Clark County District Attorney's Office.

Respondent's Answering Brief is currently due May 7, 2020. This is an appeal from the denial of Appellant's Fourth Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus, which was denied over three (3) years ago in April 2017. This Court may extend time to file a Respondent's Answering Brief upon a showing of good cause. NRAP 31(b)(3).

The State herein makes its first request for an enlargement of time. The State requests sixty (60) additional days to include July 6, 2020, within which to file Respondent's Answering Brief.
