



*ORDER*

On September 19, 2019, this court entered an order staying the issuance of the remittitur pending appellant's filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court. On December 3, 2019, this court received a notice from the Supreme Court that Justice Kagan had extended the time to file the petition to February 3, 2020, and appellant has filed a motion to continue the stay of the remittitur, asserting that he will file his petition on February 3, 2020. Issuance of the remittitur shall be stayed until February 18, 2020. See NRAP 41(b)(3). If the clerk of this court receives written notice by February 18, 2020, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice is not received by February 18, 2020, the clerk shall issue the remittitur.

It is so ORDERED.
