STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Indictment against Thomas Randolph was filed January 7, 2009 charging him with Conspiracy to Commit Murder, 2 counts of Murder with Use of a Deadly

Weapon and Burglary While in Possession of a Deadly Weapon. The State filed its Notice of Intent to Seek the Death Penalty. The attorney of record was changed several times over the next eight years, and finally the Special Public Defender was appointed. The case went to jury trial in June of 2017. Mr. Randolph was found guilty of 2 counts of First Degree Murder with use of a Deadly Weapon and 1 count of Conspiracy to Commit Murder. The jury returned a verdict of death.

The Judgment of Conviction and Notice of Appeal were both filed August 23, 2017. The direct appeal was docketed in this Court on August 25, 2017. On September 22, 2017, volumes 1-40 of the Record on Appeal were filed. Appellant filed a motion to supplement the record on appeal which was granted by this Court on November 22, 2017. The supplemental Record on Appeal, volume 41, was filed on December 4, 2017. The Record contains more than 8,600 pages.

The Opening Brief is due January 22, 2018.

Appellate counsel was not the trial attorney for Mr. Randolph and therefore must read the entire Record on Appeal as to the issues to be raised on appeal. It is respectfully requested that this Court grant a continuance of 60 days for Appellant to file the Opening Brief, up to and including March 23, 2018.

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POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

SCR 250(6)(e) states as follows:

(e) The supreme court may grant an initial extension of time of up to 60 days to file a brief upon a showing of good cause, but shall not grant additional extensions of time except upon a showing of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need.

Appellant is requesting an extension of 60 days, up to and including March 23, 2018 to file the Opening Brief.

CONCLUSION

Based on the Declaration attached hereto, Mr. Randolph requests the Court grant his motion for an extension of time to file the Opening Brief.
