


This is an appeal from an order granting Sanson's and Schneider's "anti-SLAPP" motions. The *Orders* were filed July 24, 2017 and April 24, 2018, Hon. Michelle Leavitt, District Court Judge, presiding in Dept. XII and Hon. Elizabeth Gonzalez, District Court Judge, presiding in Dept. XI respectively. Both *Orders* originated out of the hearing that took place on June 5, 2017, the Hon, Michelle Leavitt presiding.

Most recently, the two cases were consolidated, the Appendix altered accordingly, and the briefing altered to reference both Respondents. Unfortunately, one of the attorneys for Appellants, Marshal S. Willick, Esq., has had some health issues to deal with over the last few weeks that have also slowed completion.
