Deft. appealed the Judgment of Conviction (JOC) in 2003; the Supreme Court AFFIRMED with LIMITED REMAND. The JOC incorrectly indicated that Deft. pled guilty when he was actually convicted by a jury so the matter was remanded for correction of the JOC. An Amended JOC was prepared and filed on February 9, 2005.
