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## **POINTS AND AUTHORITIES**

On January 19, 2018, undersigned counsel requested a 14 day telephonic extension to file Appellants' Opening Brief, which was granted per telephonic request on that same day. On January 22, 2018, undersigned counsel suffered a serious burn to the majority of his right hand in a kitchen accident.

Undersigned Counsel was attempting to put out a grease fire accidently started in a pot of burning oil by a third party. Undersigned counsel grabbed the pot of burning oil and attempted to place it in the sink from the stove when the pot slipped from his grasp due to the heat of the handle. The burning oil spilled into the sink which had some standing water at the bottom and flared up violently, engulfing Undersigned Counsel's right hand and flaring up to the ceiling.

Undersigned Counsel was rushed to the Veteran's Administration Hospital on the night of the 22<sup>nd</sup>, of January, 2018, where he was considered "level 3" trauma, and rushed to a bed for immediate treatment. The burn to Undersigned Counsel's right hand where diagnosed as 2<sup>nd</sup> degree burns on all fingers and the palm of Undersigned Counsel's right hand. Such burns are of a severity that, if not properly treated and cared for can be life threatening.

Undersigned Counsel was rushed to University Medical Center's Burn Unit in the early hours of the 23<sup>rd</sup> of January, 2018, for specialized care as the Veteran's Administration Hospital was not equipped to handle such an emergency.

Undersigned Counsel was released latter that morning, given a prescription for narcotic painkillers, and referred to UMC's burn center for further treatment.

Since then, Undersigned Counsel has been convalescing at home, though he has made appearances in court as necessary, and when able. However, due to the pain associated with the burn, and the location of the burn, Undersigned Counsel has spent the last 10 days resting and healing, for the most part. As such, he did not receive the benefit of the extension originally granted per the telephonic request made on the 19<sup>th</sup> of January.

That initial request was made necessary by an injury suffered to Undersigned Counsel's back in July of 2017 which caused him to miss many days at work in treatment and in trips to the hospital. Undersigned Counsel is now healed sufficiently to be without painkillers and able to complete the Opening Brief by February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

Undersigned Counsel endeavored to complete the Opening Brief in the time allowed. However, the treatment schedule, pain associated with the injury, and narcotic painkillers prescribed to manage the pain, made it unfeasible.

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Therefore, Undersigned Counsel respectfully submits that extraordinary and compelling circumstances exist to grant the extension of time and the brief extension requested does not unnecessarily delay the matter or prejudice Respondents.
