ORDER TO FILE STATUS REPORT

This is an original petition for a writ of certiorari or, in the alternative, a writ of prohibition or a writ of mandamus. On October 13, 2017, we ordered the real party in interest to file an answer to the petition. The answer was filed on November 9, 2017.
