
## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF NEVADA



## ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Appellant has filed its response to this court's February 23, 2018, order to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Appellant proposes that the order appealed from effectively resolved the claims against defendant below, Gibson Road, LLC, the claims have been rendered moot, and that this court should conclude that it has jurisdiction. In the alternative, appellant requests an extension of time of 45 days to obtain certification of the appealed order pursuant to NRCP 54(b). We grant the motion for an extension of time. Appellant shall have 45 days from the date of this order to submit documentation that demonstrates this court's jurisdiction. Failure to demonstrate jurisdiction will result in dismissal of this appeal. Respondent may file any reply within 11 days of service of appellant's response. The deadlines to file the
