ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Western Cab Company and A Cab have filed an unopposed motion for leave to file a brief of amicus curiae in support of petitioners. Having reviewed the submitted brief, we grant the motion. *See Miller-Wohl Co., Inc. v. Comm'r of Labor & Indus.*, 694 F.2d 203, 204 (9th Cir. 1982) (explaining that the “classic role” of amicus is to assist in cases of general public interest and to supplement the efforts of counsel by drawing the court’s attention to law that might have escaped consideration). The clerk shall detach the proposed brief of amicus curiae from the motion filed on October 20, 2017, and file it separately. Real parties in interest shall have

11 days from the date of this order to file any answer to the amicus brief.
Such answer shall not exceed six pages or 2800 words.
