# MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWERING BRIEF (First Request)

Respondent, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department ("LVMPD"), by and through their counsel of record, Marquis Aurbach Coffing, hereby moves this Court pursuant to NRAP 31(b) for a 30-day extension of time to file its answering brief.

On April 12, 2018, this Court ordered LVMPD to file an answering brief, making LVMPD's answering brief currently due on May 14, 2018. No previous extensions have been requested. If this Court grants this request for a 30-day extension, LVMPD's answering brief will be due on June 13, 2018. Good cause exists for allowing LVMPD to extend the filing deadline until June 1, 2018:
