On March 1, 2018, this Court issued an order to show cause why the case should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. As the Court noted, appellant SFR Investments Pool 1, LLC's claims against the former homeowner, Cristela Perez and against U.S. Bank remained pending before the district court. Additionally, because of the consolidation of the cases (noted in the caption), respondent Marchai B.T.'s claims against the Association and Alessi & Koenig, as well as its complaint for judicial foreclosure remain pending.

On April 26, 2018, this Court granted SFR an additional sixty (60) days to respond to the Order to Show Cause. On April 26, 2018, default judgment was entered against Cristela Perez and U.S. Bank, disposing of SFR's claims against those parties. A true and correct copy of the Judgment is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1.** 

Counsel for Marchai expressed the intent to file for default judgment or dismissal against the remaining defendants during the time permitted by this Court, thereby disposing of all claims and parties. Thus, SFR did not seek Rule 54(b) relief at that time. At a status hearing on June 21, 2018 before the district court, Marchai indicated that due to a number of unexpected events, it had been unable to file the necessary documents to end the case. The district court granted Marchai an additional thirty days in which to obtain default judgment and dispose of any

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remaining claims. Out of all due caution, SFR will also file a motion for Rule 54(b) relief as to the claims between SFR and Marchai.

Based on the foregoing, SFR respectfully requests this Court defer ruling on the Order to Show Cause or dismissing the case for another 45 days so that the intended relief can be obtained. Counsel for Marchai is aware of the request and has authorized SFR to represent it does not oppose the additional time.

- On November 13, 2013, SFR filed a Counterclaim and Cross-Claim for quiet title and declaratory relief ("Counter/Cross-Claim") against Counter-Defendant Marchai B.T. and Cross-Defendants Perez and U.S. Bank relating to real property located at 7119 Wolf Rivers Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada 89131; Parcel No. 125-15-811-013 ("Property").
- Cross-Defendants failed to answer the complaint within the 20-day time limit set forth in 2. NRCP 12. The Clerk of the Court appropriately entered a default against Perez and U.S. Bank on February 12, 2014.
- Cross-Defendants are not incompetent, an infant or serving in the United States military. 3. NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to NRCP 55(b)(2), having considered the evidence and made the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, and finding good cause,
- 4. SFR submitted credible evidence in support of its application in the form of documents obtained from the Official Records of the Clark County Recorder and declarations made under penalty of perjury that demonstrate prima facie grounds sufficient to enter default judgment against the Cross-Defendants.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Perez, any successors and assigns, and U.S. Bank, any successors and assigns, have no right, title or interest in the Property and that SFR is the rightful title owner, but takes subject to the deed ...
