ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions. NRAP 9(c)(5).

Given this extension of time, we also extend the time for appellant to file the opening brief. Appellant shall have until October 4, 2018, to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions.
