ORDER

The stipulation of the parties extending the time for filing the briefs is approved. NRAP 31(b)(2). The answering briefs in Docket No. 76981 and joinder of Ellen Cotter, Margaret Cotter, Guy Adams, Douglas McEachern, Edward Kane, Judy Codding, Michael Wrotniak, and Mary Ann Gould to Reading International, Inc.'s brief were filed November 27, 2019. Appellant Reading International, Inc.'s reply brief in Docket No. 77733 and the answering brief of Respondent Reading International, Inc. for Docket No. 77648 were also filed on November 27, 2019.

Respondents Douglas McEachern, Edward Kane, Judy Codding, Michael Wrotniak, and Mary Ann Gould as Personal Representative of the Estate of William Gould, also move to file portions of their "Answering Brief Appendix, Volumes I and II" under seal. Respondents attach the district court's protective order entered October 23, 2015, directing that each of the volumes contains confidential papers or exhibits. See SRCR 3, 7. Cause appearing, the motion is granted. The clerk of this court shall file under seal the appendices received on December 10, 2019.
