FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER ISSUING WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS (POST-CONVICTION)

FINDINGS OF FACT

On July 7, 2014, the State of Nevada filed a Criminal Complaint against Petitioner James Ivey and co-defendants Cristopher Roach and Jeffrey German charging them with conspiracy to commit robbery, robbery with use of a deadly weapon, possession of stolen property, and possession of credit or debit card without cardholder's consent. On July 30, 2014, the State filed a Second Amended Criminal Complaint alleging counts of three counts of conspiracy to commit robbery, coercion, robbery, two counts of robbery with use of a deadly weapon, possession of stolen property, and two counts of possession of credit or debit card without cardholder's consent. Following a preliminary hearing, the justice court bound the case over for trial in this Court.

The State filed its Information on September 22, 2014. On March 16, 2015, Mr. Ivey entered a guilty plea agreement to an Amended Information charging him with robbery with use of a deadly weapon and conspiracy to commit robbery; the State retained the right to argue at sentencing. At sentencing on May 6, 2015, this Court sentenced Mr. Ivey to 60

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to 180 months as to count one with a consecutive 60 to 180 months for the weapon enhancement, and a consecutive 13 to 60 months as to count to. The Judgment of Conviction was filed May 12, 2015.

Trial counsel Carmine Colucci filed a Notice of Appeal on June 12, 2015. Remittitur issued following dismissal of that appeal as untimely. Mr. Ivey filed a timely proper person post-conviction petition for writ of habeas corpus on May 3, 2016.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Mr. Ivey was deprived of his right to effective assistance of counsel under the Sixth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States constitution, and article I, sections three, six, and eight of the Nevada Constitution. To establish a claim of ineffective assistance of counsel, the petitioner must show (1) that counsel's performance was beneath "an objective standard of reasonableness," and (2) that, but for counsel's deficiency, a different result would have been had at trial. Strickland v. Washington, 466 U.S. 668, 688 (1984); Rubio v. State, 12 Nev. 1032, 1039-40, 194 P.3d 1224, 1229 (2008). A reasonable probability is one that undermines confidence in the outcome. Strickland, 466 U.S. at 694. "Effectiveness" means performance "within the range of competence demanded of attorneys in criminal cases." Jackson v. Warden, 91 Nev. 430, 432, 537 P.2d 473, 474 (1975) (quoting McMann v. Richardson, 397 U.S. 759, 771 (1970)).

Nevada Rule of Appellate Procedure 4(b)(1)(A) provides for thirty days within which to file an appeal. NRAP 4(c)(1) provides for an untimely direct appeal after a petition for a writ of habeas corpus "asserting a viable claim that the petitioner was unlawfully deprived of the right to a timely direct appeal from a judgment of conviction and sentence." Trial counsel is obligated to file a notice of appeal when a defendant expresses such a desire. Hathaway v. State, 119 Nev. 248, 253-54, 71 P.3d 503, 507 (2003); Thomas v. State, 115 Nev. 148, 151, 979 P.2d 222, 224 (1999). When a defendant expresses a desire to appeal and counsel fails to do so, prejudice is presumed. Mann v. State, 118 Nev. 351, 353-54, 46 P.3d 1228, 1229-30 (2002).

The Judgment of Conviction in this case entered on May 12, 2015. (Ex. I.) In this case, the Notice of Appeal was due Thursday, June 11, 2015. The Notice of Appeal was instead filed the next day, June 12, 2015. (Ex. J.) Mr. Ivey is prepared to testify that he informed Mr. Colucci by writing of his intent to appeal within the thirty-day period, and Mr. Colucci failed to timely file the notice. Because trial counsel has a duty to appeal when directed by a client, and the failure to do so creates a presumption of prejudice, Mr. Ivey is entitled to the issuance of a writ of habeas corpus.

ORDER

Mr. Colucci's error deprived Mr. Ivey of his rights under the United States and Nevada constitutions. Accordingly, this Court orders the issuance of a writ of habeas corpus permitting Mr. Ivey to appeal his conviction pursuant to NRAP 4(c). The Clerk of this Court shall enter a Notice of Appeal on Mr. Ivey's behalf in accordance with that rule.

Strickland, 466 U.S. at 694. "Effectiveness" means performance "within the range of competence demanded of attorneys in criminal cases." Jackson v. Warden, 91 Nev. 430, 432, 537 P.2d 473, 474 (1975) (quoting McMann v. Richardson, 397 U.S. 759, 771 (1970)).

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ORDER

Mr. Colucci's error deprived Mr. Ivey of his rights under the United States and Nevada constitutions. Accordingly, this Court orders the issuance of a writ of habeas corpus permitting Mr. Ivey to appeal his conviction pursuant to NRAP 4(c). The Clerk of this Court shall enter a Notice of Appeal on Mr. Ivey's behalf in accordance with that rule.
