In such regard the Appellant is of the belief that the Court had dismissed his above referenced appeal under Rule 42 of the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure (hereinafter, "NRAP"), and that therefore no Remittitur issue. Whereas, the District Court refuses to rule upon several pending Motions relative to the subject matter involved in the instant appeal (Case No. 75064), until such time as a

Remittitur or a clerk's certificate in lieu of Remittitur is received by the District Court the Appellant is deprived of access to the District Court and its adjudicative process in regard to the important subject matters involved.
