#### **MEMORANDUM**

Respondent the Las Vegas Review-Journal ("Review-Journal"), by and though its undersigned counsel of record, hereby moves this Court pursuant to Nevada Rule of Appellate Procedure 31(b) for a 30-day extension of time to file its Answering Brief.

The Review-Journal's Answering Brief was originally due August 20, 2018. The parties stipulated to one thirty (30) day extension, making the Review-Journal's Answering Brief currently due on September 19, 2018. If the Court grants this request for a thirty (30) day extension, the Review-Journal's Answering Brief will be due on October 19, 2018.

This Court may "[f]or good cause" extend the time "prescribed by the [Nev. R. App. P.] or by its order to perform any act, or may permit an act to be done after that time expires." NRAP 26(b)(1)(A). Here, there is "good cause" to extend the deadline from September 19, 2018 to October 19, 2018:

1. Undersigned counsel has been having health issues and was briefly hospitalized on September 14, 2018 due to a medical emergency.

2. September 5, 2018, the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department filed an Emergency Petition for Writ of Prohibition in *Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department v. Eighth Judicial District Cou*rt, Case No. 76848, a case in which the Review-Journal is a real party in interest. On September 6, 2018, this

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Court issued an Order directing the Review-Journal to file a Response to the Emergency Petition by noon on September 10, 2018. This unanticipated emergency deadline required undersigned counsel to stop all other work to comply with the Court's Order.

3. In addition, the undersigned counsel has had competing deadlines in other matters. The undersigned also has upcoming competing deadlines, including a response to a motion to strike an appendix to answering brief, due on September 21, 2018 in *Clark County Office of the Coroner/Medical Examiner v. Las Vegas Review-Journal*, Nevada Supreme Court Case No. 74604; a hearing on September 26, 2018 in *Hartfield v. Clark County Office of the Coroner/Medical Examiner*, Eighth Judicial District Court Case No. A-18-768781-C); and a Respondent's Answering Brief due on October 8, 2018, in *Clark County School District v. Las Vegas Review-Journal*, Nevada Supreme Court Case No. 75534.

Respondent's Answering Brief is currently due September 19, 2018.
An extension is necessary in this case for the aforementioned circumstances and to ensure proper briefing. Respondent thus respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days for the Answering Brief, which would move that deadline from September 19, 2018 to October 19, 2018.

On September 11, 2018, I contacted Micah Echols, counsel for Appellant regarding the need for this extension. On September 14, 2018, Mr. Echols indicated

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Appellant has no objection to this request. The undersigned appreciates opposing counsel's professional courtesy.
