Mr. Giordani noted the State disagreed with Mr. Wooldridge assessment of the jury panel. Mr. Giordani further

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noted the concern for the State was Juror #467 provided several self-defense scenarios thereafter the Court cured the issue and the State did not follow up with Juror #467 as the reason the juror #467 was struck. Further arguments by counsel, COURT STATED its findings and ORDERED, Batson Challenge DENIED.

PROSPECTIVE JURY PANEL: Twelve jurors and three alternates selected and sworn. Jury list FILED IN OPEN COURT. Clerk read the Second Amended Indictment to the jury and stated the Defendants plea thereto. Court provided preliminary instructions to the jury. Opening statements by Mr. Rose and Mr. Wooldridge. CONFERENCE AT BENCH.

OUTSIDE PRESENCE OF JURY PANEL: Mr. Giordani argued there had been pre-trial litigation regarding the victim's history and the Defense attempted to illicit specific acts committed by the victim in order to show he was violent. Mr. Giordani noted the matter was litigated on Friday in front of Judge Villani and a specific ruling was made that anything regarding the victims prior robberies was not admissible. Mr. Giordani argued Mr. Wooldrigde violated the Court's order and this was grounds for a mistrial. Mr. Wooldrigde argued that he didn't refer to prior bad acts, he referred to the victim's reputation. Further argument by Mr. Rose. Court stated its findings and ORDERED, request DENIED for a Mistrial.
